Additional Software Rights Enhances E-Transit's Offerings in the Toll Collection and Intelligent Transportation System Markets.

The abovementioned rights permit E-Transit to modify, enhance, license and market several versions of toll collection system software, including software used at toll facilities operated by the New Jersey Turnpike, Garden State Parkway (New Jersey), E-470 (Colorado), Richmond Metropolitan Authority (Virginia), California Dept. of Transportation, St. John Harbour Bridge Authority (Canada), Halifax-Dartmouth Bridge Commission (Canada), Cobequid Pass (Canada) and others.

Included in the intellectual property are hardware and system designs, patents, and software packages for lane controllers, plaza computers, host computers, video based toll audit systems, maintenance on-line management systems, ETC customer service centers, and violation processing centers.
